Kindergarten

- 1 package of pencils
- 4 boxes of Crayola crayons (16 or 24 count)
- 4 glue sticks
- Box of tissues
- Clorox wipes
- 1 package of markers
- 4 pack of **black** fine tip Expo dry erase markers
- 1 packages of colored pencils
- 1 marble composition book

First Grade

- 2 boxes of 16 count Crayola crayons
- 2 or 4 pack of **black** fine tip Expo dry erase markers
- 2 or 4 pack of white Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 container of Lysol Wipes
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 plastic folder with pockets (any color - write your child's name on it)
- 1 composition notebook (any color - write your child's name on it)

Second Grade

- 2 boxes of crayons
- 2 or 4 pack of **black** fine tip Expo dry erase markers
- 2 Elmers glue sticks
- 1 container of Lysol Wipes
- 1 box of Kleenex
- Scissors
- 1 composition notebook - may be any color

Third Grade

- Dry erase markers - preferably Expo brand
- Elmer's glue or glue stick
- #2 pencils, 1-2 per month of school
- Pencil top erasers
- Pencil sharpener
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Scissors
- Highlighter
- 1 or 2 pocket folders
- Kleenex - 1 box per semester
- Clorox wipes
- Markers *optional*

Fourth Grade

- 36 wooden pencils - no mechanical pencils
- Cap erasers
- Colored pencils (markers will not be used)
- Black ultra-fine point Sharpie marker
- Yellow or green highlighter
- Small Post-It notes
- Whiteboard Expo markers
- 3 glue sticks
- 4 plastic two-pocket folders
- Hand sharpener for pencils
- A pair of earbuds/headphones

Fifth Grade

- Notebook / lined filler paper – WIDE RULED
- Pencils
 - If you buy mechanical pencils, please also provide EXTRA lead.
 - If you buy wooden pencils, a hand sharpener is helpful.
- 5 or 6 two-pocket folders
- Cap erasers
- White board markers (used daily in Math class)
