Three of the fire drills shall be held by December 1 of the school year, and 2 shall be held during the remaining part of the school year, with a reasonable spacing interval between each drill.

MCL 29.19 (4) A minimum of 2 tornado safety drifts is required for each school year at the schools and facilities described in subsection (1). At least 1 of the tornado safety 'rills shall be conducted during March of the school year. These drifts shall be conducted for the purpose of preventing injuries caused by severe weather.
